RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Pray for the youth, parents, and youth ministry of our church.
- Establish authentic relationships with our teenagers and their families.
- Organize weekly Youth Group meetings with the Director of Youth Ministry.
- Co-lead youth ministry events and programs including Confirmation, Youth Groups, and summer Bible Study.
- Develop and lead Senior High Sunday School.
- Assist with the organization and implementation of Love Thy Neighbor (our youth ministry to our friends in the downtown area who are experiencing homelessness).
- Attend and co-lead extra events and trips, which include ski trips, mission trips, retreats, our sixth-grade ministry, etc.
- Help with the leadership of the older elementary Vacation Bible School in conjunction with our children's ministry.
- Lead (alongside other Youth Leadership Team members) youth events when the Director of Youth Ministries is away.
- Bring innovative ideas and suggestions for our Youth Ministry to help it grow, flourish, and reveal the Kingdom of Heaven.
- Participate in leading worship as needed.
- Attend weekly Youth Ministry staff meeting.
- Attend Centenary staff meetings when appropriate.
- Organize and tend to the communications and office work necessary to the overall Youth Ministry including (but not limited to) learning the church software, "Realm," book events,

- maintain calendar, send weekly emails, manage social media platforms, overseeing registrations for events.
- Be fluent in Excel and various design work platforms
- Undergo training as to drive our church vehicles (buses and trucks) for youth ministry events.
